

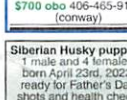

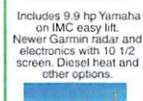

Notice is hereby given that on May 25, 2023, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved the Special Use Permit approval request (#PL22-0116) by Skagit River Systems Cooperative (SRSC), c/o Devin Smith, for a habitat enhancement and/or restoration project. The goal of the project is to improve salmon habitat and restore floodplain connectivity to portions of Reach 5 of Hansen Creek located on conservation properties owned by the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community (SITC) and Puget Sound Energy (PSE). The project is located within the Agricultural - Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning comprehensive plan designated area between State Route (SR) 20 and Minkler Road, east of Saco-Woolley, within a portion of Sections 17 & 20, Township 35N, Range 5E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P133268, P134412, P39269, P40027, P40028, P39244, P67814).

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.
