



NOTICE OF ANNUAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT PROCESS AND SUBMITTAL DEADLINE CHANGE IN 2024 The City of Ellensburg is currently accepting Comprehensive Plan amendments for the 2024 annual docket cycle. The City's Comprehensive Plan was adopted in 1995, with major updates in 2007 and 2017. The Comprehensive Plan is the City's 20-year plan for guiding future growth and development by articulating the community's vision and reflecting the community's values in 2023. The City of Ellensburg adopted Ordinance 4029 establishing a new submittal date for annual docket proposals. Proposals to amend the Comprehensive Plan may be submitted by any member of the public as well as any member of a City Board or Commission, member of City Council, or City staff. In order to be considered for docketing during the 2024 amendment cycle, proposals must be submitted by March 29, 2024, at 6pm. Applications submitted after this date will be scheduled for the 2025 annual docket cycle. City Council will consider all proposed amendments at its regular meeting on July 15, 2024, at 7:00 pm. At this meeting the City Council will determine which proposed amendments are appropriate and ready for consideration during the 2024 annual amendment process.
